




Provide energy solutions to enable a carbon neutral world

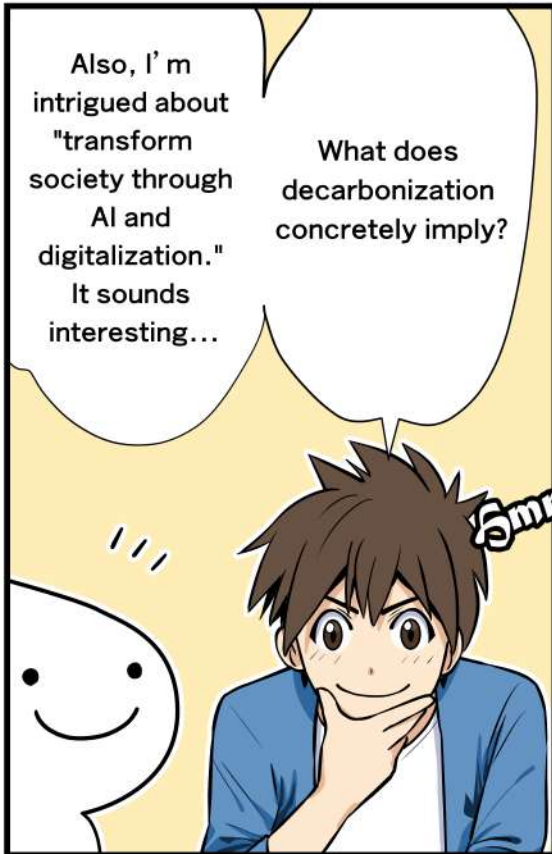

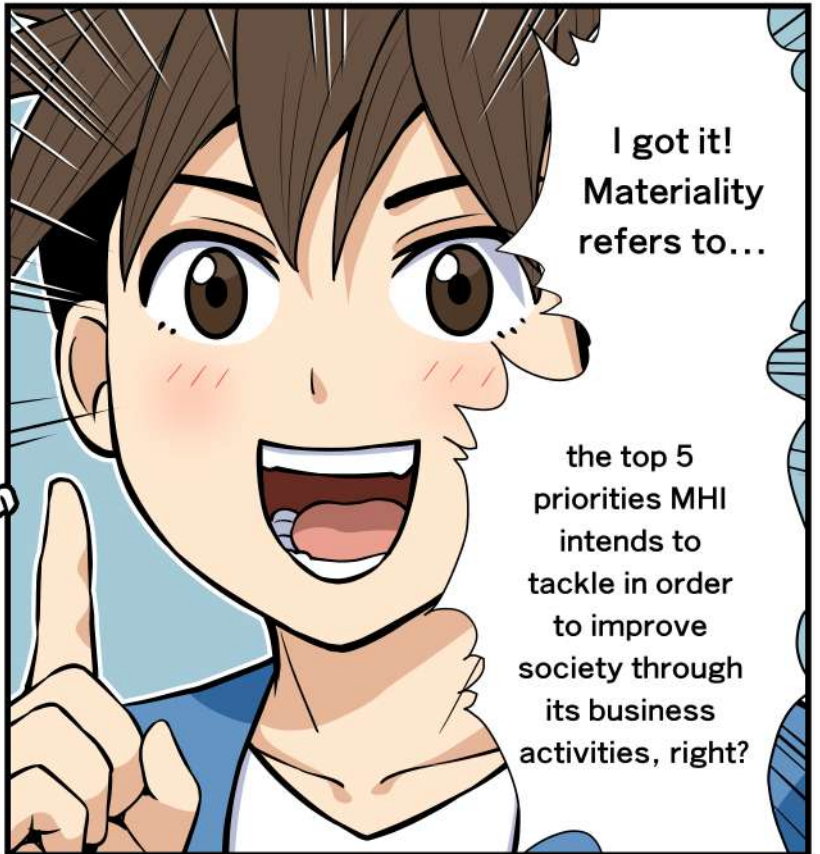
